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FORFEITURE ORDER

By the Regional Director, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Forfeiture Order* (“*Order*”), we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) to International Customs Brokers, Inc. (“ICB”), licensee of station WNTT908, in San Diego, California, for willful and repeated violation of Section 1.903(a) of the Commission's Rules (“Rules”).¹ The noted violation involves ICB’s operation of WNTT908 on an unauthorized channel.

2. On September 28, 2005, the District Director of the Enforcement Bureau’s San Diego Office issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“*NAL*”) in the amount of \$4,000 to ICB.² Despite repeated contacts by the San Diego Office, ICB has not filed a response to the *NAL*. Based on the information before us, we affirm the forfeiture.

3. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED** that, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”),³ and Sections 0.111, 0.311 and 1.80(f)(4) of the Commission’s Rules,⁴ International Customs Brokers, Inc., **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of \$4,000 for willfully and repeatedly operating station WNTT908, in San Diego, California, on an unauthorized channel, in violation of Section 1.903(a) of the Rules.⁵

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the Rules within 30 days of the release of this *Order*. If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the Department of Justice for collection pursuant to Section 504(a) of the Act.⁶ Payment of the forfeiture must be made by check or similar instrument, payable to the order of the Federal Communications Commission. The payment must include the NAL/Acct. No. and FRN No.
