ORDER

By the Deputy Chief, Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau:

1. In this *Order*, we dismiss as moot 62 petitions for waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the Commission’s rules, which requires that commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) providers be capable of transmitting 911 calls made using text telephone (TTY) devices by June 30, 2002.<sup>1</sup> A list of the companies whose petitions we dismiss is provided in the Attachment. The record in this proceeding indicates that these companies are now in compliance with Section 20.18(c). Their petitions for waiver are therefore moot.<sup>2</sup>

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the pending requests for waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 20.18(c), identified in this *Order* are DISMISSED AS MOOT to the extent indicated herein.

3. This action is taken under delegated authority pursuant to Sections 0.191 and 0.392 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.191, 0.392.
