## **ASSIGNMENT OF DOCKET NUMBER TO PROCEEDING INVOLVING CONSENT TO TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF LICENSES AND SUBSIDIARIES**

### **MB DOCKET NO. 07- 119**

On May 2, 2007, the Shareholders of Tribune Company (Tribune) and Samuel Zell filed applications seeking Commission consent to the transfer of control of Tribune, its subsidiaries, licenses, and authorizations to Zell. On May 10, 2007, the Media Bureau issued a Broadcast Actions Public Notice (Broadcast Applications, Report No. 26483) announcing that the applications had been accepted for filing and establishing a pleading cycle to permit interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed transaction. The petition-to-deny period for this application ends at close of business on June 11, 2007. 47 C.F.R. §73.3584(a).

By this Public Notice, the Media Bureau announces that this proceeding has been docketed. The docket number is MB 07-119. All parties filing pleadings or other documents in this proceeding must reference this docket number in their submissions and file them with the Secretary. The decision to docket this proceeding does not alter the original pleading cycle. As stated above, petitions-to-deny must be filed by close of business, June 11, 2007.
