On June 29, 2007, the Satellite Policy Branch granted special temporary authority to Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. (Sirius) to operate 15 terrestrial repeaters at power levels at or below 2 kW EIRP for a period of 180 days, at the locations set forth in the Exhibit attached to its application, with the technical parameters specified in its application, and subject to conditions.

On July 3, 2007, the Policy Branch granted with conditions PanAmSat Licensee Corp.'s request (PanAmSat's), File No. SAT-STA-20070627-00088. Accordingly, PanAmSat IS AUTHORIZED, for a period of 30 days commencing on July 8, 2007 to conduct space station Telemetry, Tracking, and Control (TT&C) operations on the SBS-6 satellite necessary to effect the drift of the satellite from the 74.05° W.L. orbital location to the 73.95° W.L. orbital location and while at the 73.95° W.L. orbital location and to operate the SBS-6 satellite in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) conventional Ku-band frequencies at the 73.95° W.L. orbital location in accordance with the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in its application, this Attachment, and the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) Rules.
