On June 11, 2008, the Satellite Division granted PanAmSat Licensee Corp. (PanAmSat) special temporary authority, for a period of 30 days commencing on June 16, 2008, to conduct Telemetry, Tracking, Control and Monitoring operations necessary to effect the drift of Galaxy 17 (Call Sign S2715) from the 122.9° W.L. orbital location to Galaxy 17's authorized 91.0° W.L. orbital location. Accordingly, PanAmSat is authorized to use the following frequencies: 5925.5 MHz (left-hand-circular polarization), 6424.5 MHz (right-hand-circular polarization), 5925.5 MHz (horizontal polarization) and 6424.5 MHz (vertical polarization) for command; and 4197.125 MHz (horizontal polarization), 4197.125 MHz (left-hand-circular polarization), 4198.875 MHz (horizontal polarization) and 4198.875 MHz (right-hand-circular polarization) for telemetry, subject to conditions.
