**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU AND WIRELESS
TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU ANNOUNCE COMMENT FILING DATES REGARDING
THIRD FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ON CREATION OF
NATIONWIDE, INTEROPERABLE PUBLIC SAFETY BROADBAND NETWORK**

On September 25, 2008, the Federal Communications Commission released a *Third Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* seeking comment on proposals regarding the creation of a nationwide, interoperable public safety broadband network in the 700 MHz band.¹ The *Third Further Notice* was published in the Federal Register on October 3, 2008.² Accordingly, interested parties must file comments on the issues raised in the *Third Further Notice* by **November 3, 2008**. Parties interested in submitting reply comments must do so by **November 12, 2008**.
