The Region 7 (Colorado) Public Safety Regional Planning Committee (RPC) will hold its next meeting on Wednesday, January 14, 2009, beginning at 1:00 p.m., at the State of Colorado Emergency Management Office, 9195 East Mineral Avenue, Suite 200, Centennial, Colorado.

Both Region 7 700 MHz Public Safety Regional Planning Committee and Region 7 Frequency Advisory Committee meetings are open to the public. It is essential that public safety agencies in all areas of government, including state, municipality, county, and Native American Tribal, and non-governmental organizations eligible under Section 90.523 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 90.523, be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate, and represent their agency's needs.
