On November 12, 2008, the Policy Branch granted TerreStar Networks Inc.'s (TerreStar's) request to modify its 2 GHz Mobile Satellite Service Spectrum Reservation to reflect an extension of its milestones to launch its satellite, TerreStar-1, from September 30, 2008 to June 30, 2009 and its final milestone requiring it to certify that its entire system is operational from November 30, 2008 to August 30, 2009.
