DTV channel 46 can be substituted for DTV channel 19 at Huntsville, as proposed, in compliance with the principal community coverage requirements of Section 73.625(a) of the Commission's rules,² at coordinates 34-44-19 N. and 86-31-56 W. This channel change further meets the technical requirements set forth in Sections 73.616, 73.622(f)(5), and 73.623 of the Commission's rules³ with the following specifications:
