On February 4, 2008, the Satellite Division granted with conditions special temporary authority to Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. to operate 15 terrestrial repeaters at power levels at or below 2 kW Effective Isotropically Radiated Power for a period of 180 days, in the following cities: Baltimore, MD, Chicago, IL, Cincinnati, OH, Miami, FL, New York, NY, Bogota, NJ, Wayne, NJ, Philadelphia, PA, Sacramento, CA, and Washington, D.C. from February 4, 2008 through August 1, 2008.

On February 5, 2008, the Satellite Policy Branch granted with conditions special temporary authority to XM Radio Inc. to operate one indoor terrestrial repeater in Vienna, VA, with an Effective Isotropically Radiated Power of up to 0.5 watts (average) for 180 days from February 6, 2008 to August 3, 2008, according to the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in XM's application, the attachment to the grant and the Commission's rules.
