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WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS PHASE II 220 MHz SERVICE SPECTRUM LICENSES

Auction No. 72

Report No. AUC-72 (Auction No. 72)

On June 26, 2007, the Federal Communications Commission completed the auction of 94 Phase II 220 MHz Service licenses (Auction No. 72).¹ After a preliminary review of the FCC long-form applications (FCC Form 601), five applications were accepted for filing.² Upon further review, we find that the application filed by AMTS Consortium LLC (“AMTS”) listed in Attachment A is complete and conforms to the Commission’s rules. Furthermore, the Commission has received full payment, as required by section 1.2109(a) of its rules,³ for the licenses listed in Attachment A.⁴

Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and section 0.331 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
