## **COMMISSION SETS “CUT-OFF” DATE OF JUNE 30, 2009 FOR CLASS A, LOW POWER, AND TRANSLATOR APPLICATIONS THAT ARE FILED PRIOR TO THE FULL-SERVICE STATION DIGITAL TRANSITION**

Existing analog and digital Class A, low power television, and TV translators may file displacement and minor modification applications at any time.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, existing Class A, low power, and translator stations may file applications for digital conversion (“flash-cut”) at anytime.<sup>2</sup> The Commission has received existing analog and digital Class A, low power, and translator displacement, minor modification, and flash-cut applications that do not comply with the Commission’s interference protection requirements because they are in conflict with pre-transition full-service stations’ operations. Many of these applications will be in compliance with Commission interference standards after the full-service digital transition on June 12, 2009. Therefore, any such Class A, low power, or translator application filed prior to the end of the full-service digital transition, on June 12, 2009, through June 30, 2009 will be treated for cut-off purposes as being filed on June 30, 2009.
