The Region 55 (New York – Buffalo)<sup>1</sup> Public Safety Regional Planning Committees (RPC) will hold two consecutive planning meetings on Thursday, September 24, 2009. Beginning at 10:00 a.m., the 700 MHz Public Safety RPC will convene at the Chautauqua County Emergency Services Building, Training Room 1 (Old Mayville School), 2 Academy Street, Mayville, New York.
