Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective 30 days after the date of publication of this Report and Order in the Federal Register, the Post-Transition Table of DTV Allotments, Section 73.622(i) of the Commission's rules, IS AMENDED, with respect to the community listed below, to read as follows:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That within 30 days of the effective date of this Order, Community Television of North Carolina, LLC shall submit to the Commission a minor change application for a construction permit (FCC Form 301) specifying channel 35 in lieu of channel 8 at High Point, North Carolina.
