### WC Docket No. 05-25

On June 30, 2010, the Commission released a Public Notice announcing a workshop that will be held on July 19, 2010 from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (eastern daylight time) to evaluate the analytical framework the Commission should use in reviewing its current special access rules.
