ORDER

By the Assistant Division Chief, Telecommunications Consumers Division, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this Order, which follows upon our *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“NAL”),¹ we determine that no forfeiture penalty should be imposed on Key Communications, LLC d/b/a West Virginia Wireless (“Key”).

2. On March 28, 2007, the Enforcement Bureau issued an NAL in the amount of \$100,000 to Key for its apparent violation of the Commission’s rules by failing to prepare and maintain a CPNI certification that complies with section 64.2009(e).² Consistent with section 503(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,³ Key was granted an opportunity to show, in writing, why no such forfeiture should be imposed.

3. In response to the NAL, Key provided evidence that it was no longer a Commission licensee when the NAL was issued. Accordingly, we find that no forfeiture should be imposed.

4. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED** that, pursuant to section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and sections 0.111, 0.311, and 1.80(f)(4) of the Commission’s rules, the proposed forfeiture in the NAL **WILL NOT BE IMPOSED**.
