## ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMMENT AND REPLY COMMENT DATES FOR THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING IN THE UNIVERSAL SERVICE REFORM – MOBILITY FUND PROCEEDING

Comments Due: December 16, 2010 Reply Comments Due: January 18, 2011

On October 14, 2010, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking proposing the creation of a new Mobility Fund to provide one-time support to improve coverage of current-generation or better mobile wireless service in areas where these advanced services are unavailable. The *Mobility Fund NPRM* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 45 and 75 days after publication in the Federal Register.

On November 1, 2010, a summary of the *Mobility Fund NPRM* was published in the Federal Register.<sup>2</sup> A supplement to that summary, including the proposed rules in Appendix A of the *Mobility Fund NPRM* was published separately in the Federal Register on November 12, 2010.<sup>3</sup> Comments must be filed on or before December 16, 2010; and reply comments must be filed on or before January 18, 2011. Comment filing instructions are set forth in the *Mobility Fund NPRM*.
