On March 1, 2010, Level 3, LLC, ICG Telecom Group, Inc., Looking Glass Networks, Inc., Looking Glass Networks of Virginia, Inc., Progress Telecom, LLC, and Wiltel Communications, LLC, (collectively Level 3) filed an application for review of a Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) order, in which the Bureau upheld a decision of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC). Specifically, Level 3 asserts that the Bureau erred when it upheld USAC's assessment of late fees, interest, and penalties on Level 3 due to the late filing of the Level 3 companies' revised 2008 FCC Forms 499-A.

Interested parties may file **comments on or before April 12, 2010**, and **reply comments on or before April 26, 2010**. All pleadings are to reference **WC Docket No. 06-122**. Comments may be filed using the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS), or by filing paper copies.³
