COMMENT CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING REGARDING SEPARATIONS FREEZE EXTENSION

On March 29, 2010, the Commission released a notice of proposed rulemaking seeking comment on extending, until June 30, 2011, the current freeze of Part 36 category relationships and jurisdictional cost allocation factors.¹ The Commission set the comment and reply comment deadlines for the *Notice* as 14 and 21 days, respectively, after the publication of a summary of the *Notice* in the Federal Register. On April 5, 2010, a summary of the *Notice* appeared in the Federal Register.² Accordingly, **comments are due on April 19, 2009, and reply comments are due on April 26, 2009.**
