On April 16, 2010, the Commission released an order and notice of proposed rulemaking (NPRM) that, among other things, sought comment on a proposal to provide additional universal service Link Up support to help defray charges incurred by telecommunications carriers when they must build special facilities to serve certain customers in Puerto Rico.¹

The Commission set the comment and reply comment deadline for the *Puerto Rico Order and Second NPRM* as 30 and 45 days, respectively, after publication of the summary of the NPRM in the Federal Register.² On May 7, 2010, a summary of the NPRM appeared in the Federal Register.³ Accordingly, comments will be due on **June 7, 2010**, and reply comments will be due on **June 21, 2010**.
