**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES  
REGION 13 (ILLINOIS) PUBLIC SAFETY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEES TO  
RESCHEDULE 700 MHZ AND 800 MHZ NPSPAC REGIONAL PLANNING MEETINGS**

The Region 13 (Illinois)<sup>1</sup> Public Safety Regional Planning Committees (RPCs) announce that the 700 MHz and 800 MHz Regional Public Safety planning meetings scheduled for Wednesday, May 19, 2010, at the South Jacksonville Municipal Center, 301 Dewey Drive, South Jacksonville, Illinois, **have been cancelled.**

The next meetings will be held on **Wednesday, August 18, 2010**, at the Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System (ILEAS) Headquarters, 1701 E. Main Street, Urbana, Illinois. Beginning at 10:00 a.m., the 800 MHz Public Safety RPC will convene. The purpose of the meeting is to review any pending 800 MHz applications and to address any outstanding issues. Immediately following the 800 MHz Public Safety RPC meeting, the 700 MHz Public Safety RPC will convene at the same location. The purpose of the meeting is to review pending 700 MHz applications and address any outstanding issues.

The Region 13 Public Safety RPC meetings are open to the public. All eligible public safety providers in Region 13 may utilize these frequencies. It is essential that eligible public safety agencies in all areas of government, including state, municipality, county, and Native American Tribal be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate, and represent their agency's needs.

All interested parties wishing to participate in the planning for the use of public safety spectrum in the 700 MHz and 800 MHz bands within Region 13 should plan to attend. For further information, please contact:
