## WIRELINE COMPETITION BUREAU SEEKS COMMENT ON A REQUEST BY MICTA FOR WAIVER OF THE RURAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM RULES

On January 18, 2011, MiCTA filed a request seeking a waiver of the Commission's rural health care program rules. Specifically, MiCTA requests a waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 54.603 to allow program participants to use state master contracts. MiCTA also requests a waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 54.601(c) to allow eligible participants to seek support under the rural health care program for any of the services on the universal service schools and libraries program Eligible Services List ("ESL").

Interested parties may file comments on or before **March 21, 2011**, and reply comments on or before **April 4, 2011**. All pleadings are to reference **WC Docket No. 02-60**. Comments may be filed using the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) or by filing paper copies.<sup>3</sup>

- Paper Filers: Parties who choose to file by paper must file an original and four copies of each
  filing. If more than one docket or rulemaking number appears in the caption of this proceeding,
