By the Deputy Chief, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:

1. Introduction. Paging Systems, Inc. ("PSI") filed the above-captioned applications to renew its licenses for Common Carrier Fixed Point-to-Point Part 101 Microwave Stations WLS832, WLS834, WLS838, WLS839, WLS844, WLS849, and WLS861 ("Stations").

2. Background. On January 28, 2011, PSI timely filed applications to renew Stations WLS832, WLS834, WLS838, WLS839, WLS844, WLS849, and WLS861.

3. Discussion. Most of Petitioners' arguments do not involve the instant applications; instead, Petitioners allege that PSI's conduct with respect to other licenses demonstrates that PSI lacks character and fitness to be a Commission licensee, and incorporate by reference arguments they raised in other proceedings involving other PSI licenses.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to Sections 4(i), 303(r), and 309(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 303(r), 309(d), and Sections 1.41 and 1.939 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.41, 1.939, the Petition to Deny, or in the Alternative Section 1.41 Request filed by Warren C. Havens, Environmental, LLC, Skybridge Spectrum Foundation, Intelligent Transportation & Monitoring Wireless, LLC, Verde Systems, LLC, Telesaurus Holdings GB, LLC, and V2G, LLC on March 4, 2011 IS DENIED, and applications File Nos. 0004593703, 0004593704, 0004593705, 0004593786, 0004593794, 0004593831, and 0004593941 SHALL BE PROCESSED in accordance with this *Order* and the Commission’s Rules.
