NOTICE OF DECEMBER 10 EFFECTIVE DATE OF BASIC SERVICE TIER ENCRYPTION RULES

MB Docket No. 11-169; PP Docket No. 00-67

On October 10, 2012, the Commission adopted a Report and Order in *Basic Service Tier Encryption; Compatibility Between Cable Systems and Consumer Electronics Equipment* (the *"Encryption Order"*), which amended the Commission's rules to allow cable operators to encrypt the basic service tier in all-digital cable systems if they comply with certain consumer-protection measures.¹ Those rules become effective 30 days after publication of the order in the Federal Register, which took place on November 9, 2012.² Accordingly, the rules adopted in the *Encryption Order* will take effect on December 10, 2012.³
