The Wireline Competition Bureau seeks comment on petitions filed by Q Link Wireless, LLC (Q Link), ¹ Total Call Mobile, Inc. (Total Call), ² and True Wireless, LLC (True Wireless), ³ for limited designation as eligible telecommunications carriers (ETC) for the provision of Lifeline service. Q Link, Total Call and True Wireless each seek designation as an ETC for the limited purpose of offering Lifeline service in Alabama, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia. ⁴

Pursuant to sections 1.415 and 1.419 of the Commission's rules, interested parties may file comments and reply comments on or before the dates indicated on the first page of this document. Comments may be filed using the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS).⁵

If the presentation consisted in whole or in part of the presentation of data or arguments already reflected in the presenter's written comments, memoranda or other filings in the proceeding, the presenter may provide citations to such data or arguments in his or her prior comments, memoranda, or other filings (specifying the relevant page and/or paragraph numbers where such data or arguments can be found) in lieu of summarizing them in the memorandum.
