Dear Chairman Talbott:

On March 26, 2012, the Wireline Competition Bureau issued a public notice<sup>1</sup> soliciting comments on a nomination made by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) to fill a position on the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) Board of Directors, to represent state telecommunications regulators.<sup>2</sup> This position, which is currently vacant, was formerly held by South Carolina Commissioner Randy Mitchell.<sup>3</sup> NARUC nominated Florida Commissioner Ronald A. Brisé.<sup>4</sup> The Commission received no comments in response to this nomination.
