COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON SCOPING DOCUMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A PROPOSED PROGRAM COMMENT TO GOVERN REVIEW OF POSITIVE TRAIN CONTROL FACILITIES UNDER SECTION 106 OF THE NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT

New Comment Date: November 15, 2013

On September 27, 2013, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) released a public notice seeking comment on or before November 6, 2013, in connection with the development of a proposed Program Comment to govern review of positive train control wayside facilities construction under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Due to the partial federal government shutdown occasioned by a lapse of appropriations, publication of the public notice and associated scoping document in the *Federal Register* was delayed. The Bureau therefore extends the comment date until November 15, 2013, in order to ensure all parties have a reasonable opportunity to provide comments.
