**COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON SCOPING DOCUMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A
PROPOSED PROGRAM COMMENT TO GOVERN REVIEW OF POSITIVE TRAIN
CONTROL FACILITIES UNDER SECTION 106 OF THE NATIONAL HISTORIC
PRESERVATION ACT**

New Comment Date: November 15, 2013

On September 27, 2013, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) released a public notice seeking comment on or before November 6, 2013, in connection with the development of a proposed Program Comment to govern review of positive train control wayside facilities construction under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.¹ Due to the partial federal government shutdown occasioned by a lapse of appropriations, publication of the public notice and associated scoping document in the *Federal Register* was delayed. The Bureau therefore extends the comment date until November 15, 2013, in order to ensure all parties have a reasonable opportunity to provide comments.
