## NOTICE OF NON-STREAMLINED DOMESTIC 214 APPLICATION GRANTED

WC Docket No. 13-241

Pursuant to section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and sections 0.91, 0.291, and 63.03 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, and 63.03, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) approves the application of Montana Opticom, LLC (Opticom) and 3 Rivers Telephone Cooperative, Inc. to transfer Opticom's interstate telecommunications facilities and operations in the Big Sky exchange in the Madison and Gallatin Counties of Montana to 3 Rivers Community Telephone Company, Inc.<sup>1</sup> No comments were filed in opposition to the application.
