FORFEITURE ORDER

By the Chief, Spectrum Enforcement Division, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this Forfeiture Order, we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) to Inter Tech FM (Inter Tech) for willful and repeated violations of Section 302(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 2.803(a) of the Commission's rules¹ with respect to Inter Tech's marketing of FM broadcast transmitters and external radio frequency power amplifiers without prior Commission authorization.

2. On July 10, 2009, the Enforcement Bureau's Spectrum Enforcement Division issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture (NAL)* to Inter Tech in the amount of $22,000^2$ Inter Tech did not file a response to the *NAL*. Based on the information before us, we affirm the 22,000 forfeiture proposed in the *NAL*.

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED THAT**, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.111, 0.311, and 1.80 of the Commission's rules,³ Inter Tech FM **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) for willful and repeated violations of Section 302(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 2.803(a) of the Commission's rules.⁴

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the Commission's rules within five (5) calendar days after the release date of this Forfeiture Order.⁵ If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the U.S. Department of Justice for enforcement of the forfeiture pursuant to Section 504(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.⁶ Inter Tech FM shall send electronic notification of payment to Nissa Laughner at

5. The payment must be made by check or similar instrument, wire transfer, or credit card, and must include the NAL/Account number and FRN referenced above. Regardless of the form of payment, a completed FCC Form 159 (Remittance Advice) must be submitted.⁷ When completing the FCC Form 159, enter the Account Number in block number 23A (call sign/other ID) and enter the letters "FORF" in block number 24A (payment type code). Below are additional instructions you should follow based on the form of payment you select:

- Payment by check or money order must be made payable to the order of the Federal Communications Commission. Such payments (along with the completed Form 159) must be mailed to Federal Communications Commission, P.O.
