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ADDITIONAL \$16.7 MILLION IN CONNECT AMERICA PHASE I SUPPORT AUTHORIZED

WC Docket No. 10-90

By this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) authorizes \$16,713,875 in additional Phase I second round incremental support in response to the modified elections of two carriers, AT&T and Windstream Communications (Windstream). The *Phase I Challenge Resolution Order* permitted carriers that made conditional elections to modify their elections, identifying additional locations in census blocks that were previously authorized.¹ AT&T² and Windstream³ chose to modify their elections. The Bureau authorizes \$5,248,300 in additional Phase I incremental support for AT&T in exchange for AT&T's commitment to deploy broadband-capable infrastructure to 6,772 additional locations. The Bureau also authorizes \$11,465,575 in additional Phase I incremental support for Windstream in exchange for Windstream's commitment to deploy to an additional 13,273 locations.⁴ The Bureau directs the Universal Service Administrative Company to distribute this authorized funding as set forth in the Attachment to this Public Notice.

Petition for Partial Reconsideration of Farmers Telephone Company of Riceville, Iowa and Omnitel Communications, Inc., WC Docket No. 10-90 (filed Feb. 7, 2014). Windstream has indicated that it would deploy to 27 locations in those five blocks. Pending action on that petition for reconsideration, the Bureau does not authorize funding for the locations in the disputed census blocks.
