**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

By the Chief, Media Bureau:

1. On July 15, 2010, the Commission adopted the Order in the above-captioned docket to facilitate the introduction of television receivers with Mobile DTV tuners that are designed to be used in motion.<sup>1</sup> Elgato Systems, LLC (“Elgato”) filed an Application for Review on August 4, 2010, seeking reconsideration of particular aspects of this Order.

2. Due to the passage of time, Elgato has agreed to withdraw its Application. Therefore, with no objections put forth by petitioner, we are dismissing the application without prejudice.

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that Elgato’s Application for Review is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.

4. **IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), and 4(j) of the Communications Act, 47 USC 154(i) and (j), and Section 0.61 of the Commission’s rules, that Media Bureau Docket No. 10-111 **IS TERMINATED**.

5. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.283 of the Commission’s rules. 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
