Media Bureau Announces Comment and Reply Comment Dates For DBS Market Modification Notice of Proposed Rulemaking

MB Docket No. 15-71

Comments Due: May 13, 2015

Replies Due: May 28, 2015

On March 26, 2015, the Commission adopted and released the DBS Market Modification Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (*NPRM*).¹ In the *NPRM*, the Commission proposes satellite television market modification rules to implement Section 102 of the Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act Reauthorization Act of 2014 (STELAR). The *NPRM* also proposes to make conforming changes to the cable market modification rules and considers whether to make any other changes to the current market modification process.

By this Public Notice, the Media Bureau announces that the DBS Market Modification *NPRM* was published in the Federal Register on April 13, 2015,² starting the pleading cycle for the proceeding in MB Docket No. 15-71. Accordingly, comments must be submitted no later than May 13, 2015, and reply comments must be submitted no later than May 28, 2015.³ Commenters must follow the filing instructions provided in the *NPRM*.⁴ The *NPRM* is available on the Commission's website.⁵
