NON-SERVICE-INITIALIZED PHONES PROCEEDING**

On April 1, 2015, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the Non-Service-Initialized Phones proceeding (*NPRM*).<sup>1</sup> The *NPRM* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days after publication in the Federal Register.

On May 6, 2015, a summary of the *NPRM* appeared in the Federal Register.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, comments will be due on or before June 5, 2015, and reply comments will be due on or before July 6, 2015. The *NPRM* sets forth the comment filing instructions.
