## MEDIA BUREAU SEEKS COMMENT ON HAUPPAUGE'S PETITION FOR WAIVER OF OVER-THE-AIR ANALOG TUNER REQUIREMENTS

Hauppauge Computer Works, Inc. ("Hauppauge") has filed a petition<sup>1</sup> requesting that the Commission waive Section 15.117(b) of the Commission's rules. Section 15.117(b) states that "[u]ntil August 31, 2017, TV broadcast receivers shall be capable of adequately receiving all channels allocated by the Commission to the television broadcast service." Hauppauge seeks a waiver of Section 15.117(b) in order to import, market, distribute and sell "a USB plug-in [that] adds the capacity of two high definition TV tuners to a computer system" and does not include analog tuners. We seek comment on Hauppauge's request.

This proceeding will be treated as "permit but disclose" for purposes of the Commission's *ex parte* rules. *See* 47 C.F.R. § § 1.1200, 1.1206. As a result of the permit-but-disclose status of this proceeding, *ex parte* presentations will be governed by the procedures set forth in Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules applicable to non-restricted proceedings.<sup>4</sup>

Pursuant to sections 1.415 and 1.419 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR §§ 1.415, 1.419, interested parties may file comments and reply comments on or before the dates indicated on the first page of this document.
