**ORDER**

By the Senior Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau

1. On December 6, 2016, Petitioner La Plata County, Colorado (“La Plata”) filed a motion requesting a one-week extension of the time within which to file a response to the Opposition to Petitions for Special Relief (“Opposition”) filed by KOAT Hearst Television Inc. (“KOAT”) and KOB-TV, LLC (“KOB-TV”) in the above-referenced proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Petitioner La Plata requests this extension up to and including Wednesday, December 14, 2016, to prepare its response because the Petitioner did not receive the Opposition until November 29, 2016.<sup>2</sup> KOAT and KOB-TV have consented to the requested extension.<sup>3</sup>

2. The Commission does not routinely grant extensions of time,<sup>4</sup> but the rights at issue in this proceeding are significant and important to a wide range of interested parties. Thus, we grant a one-week extension for pleadings, establishing a new deadline of December 14, 2016.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to Section 4(i) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 154(i), and Sections 0.51, 0.283, and 1.46 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.51, 0.283, and 1.46, that the motion for extension of time filed by La Plata is granted, and the deadline for submission of pleadings is accordingly extended to December 14, 2016.
