1. On November 28, 2016, Comcast Cable Communications, LLC, on behalf of its subsidiaries and affiliates (“Comcast”) filed a Motion to Withdraw its Petition for Special Relief in the above-referenced proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Comcast asserts that good cause exists for granting this request, as it will relieve the Commission of having to resolve the market modification dispute at issue.<sup>2</sup> In view of the foregoing, we grant Comcast’s Motion to Withdraw its Petition.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to Section 4(i) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 154(i), and Sections 0.61, 0.283 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.61, 0.283, that the Motion to Withdraw filed by Comcast Communications, LLC, on behalf of its subsidiaries and affiliates, **IS GRANTED**.
