## RURAL BROADBAND AUCTIONS TASK FORCE ANNOUNCES WEBINAR TO DISCUSS PROPOSALS PUT FORTH IN THE MOBILITY FUND PHASE II CHALLENGE PROCESS COMMENT PUBLIC NOTICE

On October 18, 2017, the Rural Broadband Auctions Task Force (Task Force), along with the Wireline Competition Bureau and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the Bureaus), released the Mobility Fund Phase II (MF-II) Challenge Process Comment Public Notice, which seeks comment on detailed proposals for conducting the MF-II Challenge Process.
