Nature of Service: Direct to Home Fixed Satellite, Fixed Satellite Service

On March 30, 2017, the Satellite Division granted, with conditions, the request of SES Americom, Inc. to modify the authorization for the AMC-2 space station at the 84.85° W.L. orbital location to add operations in the conventional C-band. Specifically, this grant authorizes SES Americom to provide fixed-satellite service (FSS) in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. SES is also authorized to continue operating pursuant to previously granted waivers of Sections 25.210(j) and 25.114(c)(4) of the Commission's rules.
