By the Chief, Media Bureau:

1. On April 4, 2017, the Bureau released a Public Notice seeking comment on a petition filed by the Multifamily Broadband Council (MBC). That Public Notice established May 4, 2017 as the deadline for filing comments and May 19, 2017 as the deadline for filing reply comments in response to MBC’s petition. On April 7, 2017, the City and County of San Francisco filed a motion for “extension of two weeks for the comments, through and including May 18, 2017, and three weeks for the reply comments, through and including June 9, 2017” to “allow a more complete and factual record to be developed.” The California Association of Competitive Telecommunications Companies filed in support of the request and noted that its outside counsel is currently travelling abroad. Under Section 1.46(a) of the Commission’s rules extensions of time are not routinely granted, but we find good cause in this case to waive the Commission’s rule in this case to develop a more complete record in response to the Petition.

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to sections 4(i) and 4(j) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 154(j) and Sections 0.61, 0.283 and 1.46 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.61, 0.283 and 1.46, the deadline for filing comments IS EXTENDED to May 18, 2017, and the deadline for filing replies IS EXTENDED to June 9, 2017.
