ORDER

By the Senior Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau:

1. On various dates, the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel (Rate Counsel) filed an Application for Review (collectively, the Applications) in each of the above-captioned proceedings, in which the Media Bureau made a determination of effective competition.¹ On September 24, 2018, Rate Counsel filed a letter withdrawing with prejudice the Applications.² We hereby grant Rate Counsel's request.

2. Accordingly, the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel's Request for Withdrawal **IS GRANTED** and the Applications for Review in the above-captioned proceedings **ARE DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by Section 0.283 of the Commission's rules.³
