MOBILITY FUND PHASE II CHALLENGE PROCESS PORTAL UPDATE: JULY 2018

WT Docket No. 10-208

The Rural Broadband Auctions Task Force (Task Force), in conjunction with the Wireline Competition Bureau and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the Bureaus), today provides the third update about the Mobility Fund Phase II (MF-II) challenge process.

As of July 31, 2018, a total of 93 entities have access to the Universal Service Administrator Company (USAC) MF-II Challenge Process Portal to participate in the MF-II challenge process. Of these entities, 38 are mobile service providers required to file Form 477 data; 15 are state government entities; 20 are local government entities; 15 are Tribal government entities; and five are other entities that have filed petitions requesting, and have each been granted, a waiver to participate.¹ To date, challengers have submitted data including 1,672,497 speed tests.
