**Nature of Service:** Fixed Satellite Service

On February 26, 2019, the Satellite Division granted, with conditions, SES Americom, Inc. request to access the U.S. market to provide fixed-satellite service through a Gibraltar-licensed Ku-band space station, NSS-11, at the 176.0° E.L. orbital location. Specifically, the Satellite Division added NSS-11 at 176.0° E.L. to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List for fixed satellite service in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency band and granted market access in the 12.25-12.75 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency band.
