COMMISSION ANNOUNCES 39 GHZ RECONFIGURATION PROCEDURES WEBINAR AND HOW TO PARTICIPATE

The Commission hereby announces that the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau in cooperation with the Office of Economics and Analytics will host a webinar on the initial 39 GHz reconfiguration procedures on April 4, 2019, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Eastern Time. The webinar will help interested parties understand and provide comment on the Initial 39 GHz Reconfiguration Procedures Public Notice, DA 19-196, released March 20, 2019. The webinar will include an overview of the reconfiguration process and examples of key steps in it, including the proposals on which we are seeking comment. This Public Notice presents the necessary details for interested parties and the general public to participate in the webinar, as well as instructions for later viewing.

The webinar will be streamed live with open captioning over the Internet.
