PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES COMMENT AND REPLY COMMENT DATES FOR THE FOURTH FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING IN THE WIRELESS E911 LOCATION ACCURACY PROCEEDING

On March 15, 2019, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a *Fourth Further Notice* of *Proposed Rulemaking* to improve wireless E911 location accuracy.¹ The *Fourth FNPRM* proposed a vertical (z-axis) location accuracy metric of plus or minus 3 meters relative to the handset for 80% of indoor wireless E911 calls for each of the benchmarks and geographic requirements previously established in the Commission's E911 wireless location accuracy rules.² The *Fourth FNPRM* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 45 and 75 days, respectively, after publication of a summary of the *Fourth FNPRM* in the Federal Register.³

On April 4, 2019, the Office of the Federal Register published a summary of the *Fourth FNPRM*, including the associated comment and reply comment dates.⁴ Accordingly, comments must be filed on or before May 20, 2019, and reply comments must be filed on or before June 18, 2019.⁵ The *Fourth FNPRM* contains the comment filing instructions.
