TECHNICAL GUIDES ON PROPOSED BIDDING PROCEDURES FOR AUCTION 103 (UPPER 37 GHZ, 39 GHZ, AND 47 GHZ)

The Office of Economics and Analytics (Office), in conjunction with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau), today makes available guides that provide technical and mathematical detail regarding the proposed bidding and assignment procedures for Auction 103 (Upper 37 GHz, 39 GHz, and 47 GHz). These guides provide examples and serve as supplements to the bidding and bid processing procedures for the clock and assignment phases as proposed by the Commission in the *Auction 103 Comment Public Notice*.¹ The guides, which are entitled *Auction 103 Clock Phase Technical Guide* and *Auction 103 Assignment Phase Technical Guide*, respectively, are available on the Commission's Auction 103 website (www.fcc.gov/auction/103), where they will remain available and accessible for reference.
