**ORDER**

By the Chief, Media Bureau:

1. On August 5, 2020, AMC Networks Inc. (AMCN) filed a program carriage complaint against AT&T Inc.<sup>1</sup> On September 11, 2020, AMCN submitted a request to withdraw and dismiss its Complaint with prejudice.<sup>2</sup> AMCN states that it has entered into an agreement for carriage with AT&T Inc.<sup>3</sup> In light of this agreement, we grant AMCN’s request to withdraw and dismiss its Complaint with prejudice.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that AMCN’s request to withdraw and dismiss with prejudice its Complaint **IS GRANTED**, that the Complaint is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, and that this proceeding **IS TERMINATED** and the docket is closed.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.283 of the Commission’s rules.<sup>4</sup>
