On October 26, 2020, the Satellite Division granted, with conditions, the request of DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC, to modify the license for its T8 space station to specify operations at the 119.05° W.L. orbital location instead of the previously authorized orbital location of 100.75° W.L. DIRECTV will provide Direct Broadcast Satellite Service at 119.05 W.L. using the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands, and operate telemetry, tracking, and command using the following center frequencies: 12203.25 MHz and 12203.75 MHz (space-to-Earth), and 17307.00 MHz (Earth-to-space).

This application, which was accepted for filing on October 23, 2020, see Satellite Policy Branch Information, Space Stations Accepted for Filing, Report No. SAT-01507, was also referred on that date to the relevant Executive Branch agencies for views on any national security, law enforcement, foreign policy or trade policy concerns. On October 28, 2020, the Chair of the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Services Sector (Committee) requested that the Commission defer action on the application while the Committee reviews the application for any national security and law enforcement concerns that may be raised by foreign participation in the United States telecommunications services sector. Pursuant to Executive Order 13913 (85 Fed Reg 19643 (April 8, 2020)), the Chair will notify the Commission when the Chair has determined that the 120-day initial review period has begun.
