Special Temporary Authority

Grant of Authority

On February 10, 2020, the Satellite Division granted, with conditions, special temporary authority to Space Exploration Holdings, LLC., for a period of 30 days, to continue to conduct Launch and Early Orbit Operations and payload testing for the second tranche of up to 60 satellites of its non-geostationary orbit Starlink constellation in the 10.7-12.7 GHz, 17.8-18.6 GHz, 18.8-19.3 GHz, and 19.7-20.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.0-14.5 GHz, 28.35-29.1 GHz, and 29.5-30.0 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. SpaceX was also granted authority to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command operations at 12.221 GHz (space to Earth) and 13.925 GHz (Earth-to-space) to orbit-raise its 60 satellites from the initial payload-testing altitude of 350 km to an altitude of 550 km and to place those satellites in orbital planes recently authorized in SpaceX's modification, DA 19-1034.
