**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES  
REGION 28 (EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA, SOUTHERN NEW JERSEY AND DELAWARE  
AREA) REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEES TO HOLD 700 MHZ AND 800 MHZ  
MEETINGS**

The Region 28 (Delaware, Eastern Pennsylvania, and Southern New Jersey Area) 700 MHz and 800 MHz Regional Planning Committees (RPCs)<sup>1</sup> will hold a planning meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 2020. Beginning at 10:00 a.m., the 800 MHz RPC and 700 MHz RPC meeting will convene at the Delaware River and Bay Authority complex at 2162 New Castle Avenue, New Castle, Delaware<sup>2</sup>. All eligible public safety providers whose sole purpose or principal purpose is to protect the safety of life, health, or property within Region 28 would utilize these frequencies. government, Native American Tribal, and non-governmental organizations eligible under Section 90.523 of the Commission's Rules be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not conversant with telecommunications technology should ensure that suitably conversant staff represent their respective agencies.

All interested parties wishing to participate in the planning for the use of the Public Safety spectrum in the 700 MHz and/or 800 MHz bands within Region 28 are encouraged to attend.
